

The Disease Control (Interim Measures) (Scotland) Order 2002
(As Amended)
Information Note for Exhibitors

The names and addresses of all exhibitors and other persons handling stock at Show or Exhibitions should be recorded by the person responsible for the stock and retained by the organisers for three months beyond the date of the event. The organisers should provide the information to the DVM or his staff or local Animal Health Inspector if requested to do so.

If you are exhibiting cattle or sheep, please complete the form below and hand in to the Secretary's Tent along with entry money, prior to unloading of animals.

Sheep moving to shows or exhibitions must be individually ear tagged in accordance with SEERAD guidance. The movement to and from the show has to be reported to the Scottish Animal Movement Unit, Edinburgh, Fax; 0131 244 1964 or email samu@scotland.gsi.gov.uk with individual ear tags numbers listed as this involves a movement from one premises to another. This is responsibility of the stock owner & **NOT** the **SHOW ORGANISER**.
